- . A Difference in our logic

- We have a different mind set than the world
- Our views are different than world’s views
- My thoughts are not my thoughts, your ways not My ways Isaiah 55:8

A. We Must Have a Compassionate Mind

Phil. 2:4-8 KJV Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

- We should be more concerned about the needs of others than our own needs.
- The mind-set of the world is me, myself, & I.

B. We Must Have a Consecrated Mind [set apart; dedicated Colossians 3:1-5 NKJV

If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things. As Christians in the world we often try to hide our faith out of fear but God has given us his Holy Spirit to overcome our fears and be bold witnesses in this world.
